
Parrot

Materials:

- Newspaper
- Sheet of White Tissue Paper
- Two Paper Plates
- Small piece of Thick Card
- Florist's Stem Wire
- Masking Tape
- Scissors
- Elmer's Glue-All (or similar)
- Glue brush
- Poster or Acrylic Paints
- Felt Tip Pens (Black and Red)

How to make a Paper Parrot in a Cage

The complete parrot and cage is about 18 inches



To make the cage, several tight rolls of newspaper fastened well with masking tape, then painted white, make good bars. The bottom of the tubes can then be secured around the edge of a paper plate, and then the parrot on his perch can be placed in the middle of the plate before securing the tops of the newspaper tubes to another paper plate. Strips of paper glued around the top and bottom of the bars will provide extra strength to the cage. A handle can be made from a ring of cardboard fastened to the top of the cage
