How to make a Penguin

Materials:

- A large paper cup
- Egg Box
- Newspaper
- Masking tape
- Kitchen tissue
- White tissue paper
- Sheet of thin white card
- Stem wire
- Coloured Acrylic or Poster Paint
- Hot Glue Gun
- Elmer's 'Glue All' or similar
- Scissors and Felt tip pen
- Glue brush and paint brush





1. The eye and beak section of the penguin is made by cutting out the shape as above, from an egg box.



2. The eye and beak section is then taped to the base of an upturned cup. The cup is padded at the front with folded newspaper and short flat paper tubes are taped at the sides for flippers.



3. Two ovals of card are taped to the rim of the cup as shown, then padded out with small fat rolls of kitchen tissue to make the feet. The penguin is then covered with strips of glued tissue and left to dry before painting.



4. The ski sticks are made from small wired paper tubes with tiny card circles hot glued near the ends. They are then hot glued beneath his flippers. Skis cut from card are then hot glued to the feet. The penguin is then painted.
